10. Speed Limit Review Area 12

It was decided it was not necessary to comment on the Speed Limit Review for Area 12.

11. Aylesbury Vale Joint Sports Council

Cllr Webber reported that the Sports Council will be changing their policy on issuing funding and will no longer be supporting clubs and organisations, although they would continue to support talented individuals sponsored by clubs. Therefore, it was decided not to renew the Parish Council's membership with the Aylesbury Vale Joint Sports Council, as it would no longer be of any benefit. Cllr. Robson expressed the Parish Council's gratitude to Cllr. Webber for attending the Sports Council meetings over a number of years.

12. Sports Centre Hire

It was decided not to have any policy in place if a booking is cancelled at short notice. It was agreed that if the situation arises in the future it should be dealt with individually.

13. Local Development Framework

Cllr. Robson reported that the Examination in Public of the Core Strategy was now underway. Cllrs. Robson and Miller will be giving evidence along with the Action Group. It was agreed to put a notice on the notice boards and on the back of the next village diary, reminding parishioners to respond to the consultation on the Masterplan and Delivery schedule.

14. Recreation Ground

Cllr. Cotton asked for the report on the Mobile Skate Park to be deferred until the next meeting.

The Clerk reported that a concrete plinth would cost £180 plus VAT per bench. It was agreed that the clerk should go ahead and order a plinth for the replacement and new benches.
