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7. Recreation Ground

Pre- School – It was agreed that pre-school should submit a formal plan to the Clerk for the proposed fenced off outside play area so that a decision can be made at the September Parish Council meeting.

Football – Bierton FC now have a new committee. There will be a meeting on Tuesday 20th July 2010 with the committee, to discuss cleaning arrangements and any other issues. Cllrs Cotton and Webb and the Parish Clerk will represent the Parish Council.

Sunday Football – A junior football team have asked to use the recreation ground on Sunday mornings – it was agreed that this is acceptable.

8. **NAG Meeting Feedback** – It was reported that NAG claim they have conquered the Great Lane anti-social behaviour problem, but they will keep monitoring the situation. Speed checks in Burcott Lane are still being carried out.

9. **Vandalism** - It was noted that there has been some incidents of anti-social behaviour at St. Osyth's Well. A parishioner had requested that the apple trees should be removed as the apples were being thrown into neighbouring gardens and a window had been broken. However, whilst the Parish Council are sympathetic to the nuisance caused it was decided not to remove the apple trees.

10. **Transforming Day Services in Bucks** – Cllr Cotton attended a meeting on Day Care Services and reported that she has filled in a questionnaire. Cllr. Cotton reported that no decision on transforming Day Services in Bucks has been made yet. A report will be put in the circulation envelope for members of the Parish Council to read.

11. **Playground Inspections** – It was agreed that the Clerk should ask Tim Francis to rub down and treat, where necessary, any woodwork in the play area.

12. **Local Development Framework** – Cllr. Robson reported that County Cllr Paternoster has made a statement following the Government Inspector's interim report. There will be a full council meeting on 8th September. A representative from the Parish Council may be able to make a statement at this meeting. It was agreed that the Parish Council should keep up the pressure on opposing the Eastern Arc proposal.

13. Planning Applications:

Badricks Farm, 94 Aylesbury Road

10/00785/ALB, 10/00786/APP, 10/784/ACD, 10/00782/APP, 10/00783/ACD – No objections.

Proposed mass burn incineration – it was decided that there was no need for Bierton Parish Council to be involved in any protest as the village would not be directly affected by the proposals.

HS2 – It was agreed the Parish Council should continue to monitor any information on HS2 but as we would not be directly affected there is no need to be involved in any protest.

Proposed Wind Farm – Wingrave – Cllr. Robson attended a meeting in Wingrave and reported that an Action Group will be formed between Wingrave, Rowsham and Hulcott. It was agreed that information on the Wind Farm should be put in the next village diary to inform parishioners of the proposals.

14. Planning Determinations

10/00812/ADC – Land at Circus Field, Oakfield Road – Construction of canal basin and private club house for Aylesbury Canal Society incorporating wet and dry docks, boaters facilities and formation of new access off Stocklake – It was reported that this development has been approved at the meeting on 16th July 2010.

15. Consultations

Buckingham Town Council – Local Governance Consultation – It was decided not to respond to this consultation.

16. Matters of Report

- Cllr. Ash reported that the grass verge and paving stones at 89 Aylesbury Road have been repaired.
- It was noted that Irene Corns, the Head at Bierton School is retiring. The Clerk was asked to send a letter to wish Mrs Corns a happy retirement and thank her for all her support in the village and hard work at the school over the years.
- Sports Centre Users Meeting – it was agreed that the Clerk and Cllr Cotton should agree a date for the meeting.
- It was noted that geophysical surveying was being carried out in Burcott Lane near to the Dog House Public House.
- Cold callers – It was suggested that notices could be put up in the villages regarding cold callers not being welcome. The Clerk and Cllr Cotton were asked to contact the BALC Secretariat and NAG respectively to find out where to source the notices.

There being no further business the Chairman closed the meeting at 10.46 pm.
