MINUTES OF PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 18th JANUARY 2010

3. **Minutes of Last Meeting:** Accepted as true record and duly signed.
4. **Public Forum** – No parishioners present.

5. Clerk's Report

Councillor Webber to decide whether the hedge in front of houses along Great Lane needs to be cut short next year.

6. Finance

- 1. The Clerk reported that there is still £411 outstanding of S106 money, which must be spent before May. It was decided to purchase a new bench for the recreation ground, which will be sited adjacent to the hedge near to the play area. Cllr. Webber to agree positioning when the bench arrives. It was also decided to stand this and the replacement for the bench which was vandalised on a concrete plinth.

It was noted that Watermead Parish Council will be sending an invoice for half of the cost of the flyers delivered to every household in Bierton with Broughton and Watermead Parishes, giving an update on the Aylesbury Growth Arc, particularly the exhibitions on the Masterplan. The Council agreed to the payment.

Cllr. Mrs J Vaughan thanked the Parish Council, on behalf of the Jubilee Hall Management Committee for the kind donation of £500 towards the cost of the refurbishment of the toilets.

The budget was agreed (as attached).

It was also agreed to increase the use of the Sports Centre by 1% as from 1st April 2010.

It was agreed to donate £100 to the Coombe Hill Monument Appeal.

7. Notice board

8. Badricks Farm

It was decided that the Clerk should write to Carter Jonas, who intend to submit a planning application that involves the change of use of the farmstead buildings to create five dwellings, and inform them that the Parish Council do not wish to make any comments, but reserve the right to comment unconditionally when the plans are submitted to AVDC.

9. Speed Limit Review Areas 12 and 13

It was noted that the public consultation is in March and the Parish Council will need to decide whether to make any comments, when details of the proposals are received.

10. Local Development Framework

Cllr Robson gave an update. The Government Inspector's hearing commences on 2nd February 2010; Cllr Robson and Miller will attend and are registered to speak, other Councillors are welcome to provide support. The Parish Council remains opposed to the proposed housing development and will be submitting further statements during the consultation period for the Masterplan.

11. BALC – Parish Liaison Project

It was decided that the Chairman, the Clerk and any councillors who were available, would attend a meeting with BALC. The Clerk was asked to arrange a suitable date with BALC.

12. Sports Centre

- It was noted that there is be an extended entitlement from 12.5 hours to 15 hours per week for pre-school children. We await an approach from the Pre-School management if it affects current arrangements.
- It was decided to charge the Red Cross and Florence Nightingale House the regular user rate for bookings in June this year.
