# Gib Lane Community Fund

#### Introduction

Gib Lane Solar Farm is a development located south-east of Aylesbury in Buckinghamshire.

The developer, Haymaker (Gib Lane Solar) Ltd, has committed an annual contribution each year (index-linked), for 25 years, into a Community Fund.

In 2024, there will be £14,896 available for grants.

The Gib Lane Community Fund is now in its tenth year of funding, having already committed over £94,000 towards a variety of community projects.

### Amounts Available

The Fund is divided up according to how much of the development was located within each Parish when it was constructed.

Groups located in one of the four Parishes can apply for grants of £250 up to the maximum amount available in their Parish each year. The amounts available for 2024 are indicated in brackets below:

- Bierton -38% (£5,660)
- Hulcott-14% (£2,085)
- Aston Clinton –29% (£4,320)
- Buckland -19% (£2,830)

## What can I apply for?

Priority will be given to:

- Energy efficiency or renewable energy projects, such as insulation, efficient boilers or small scale renewable energy installations.
- Projects for school age children, or older people.
- Any other community projects for the benefit of residents of the local area.

# How do I apply for a grant?

The Fund is being administered by national grant-making charity GrantScape. All applicants will need to submit a simple online application form. There is one application round per year so it is important that groups submit their application by the closing date, even if their project doesn't need the grant for several months.

The next closing date for applications is: Wednesday 18 September 2024.
